ORDINANCE 2026-001 AMENDING SECTION 102-2A (3) & (4)
REMOVING LICENSING REQUIREMENTS AND FEES FOR
MOBILE FOOD VENDORS AND TEMPORARY RETAIL FOOD
ESTABLISHMENTS

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Alexandria desires to amend the Category 3 retail food establishment license requirements and fees set forth at Ordinance Section 102-2 A (3) for mobile food vendors and Section 102-2 (4) temporary retail food establishment license requirements and fees; and

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2026, the Hunterdon County Health Department will oversee the licensing and fee collection of mobile food vendors and temporary retail food establishments eliminating the need for the Township of Alexandria to issue these licenses and collect fees in accordance with N.J.A.C 8:2-1.1 et. seq; and

WHEREAS, mobile food vendors and temporary retail food vendors will still be required to apply for fire permits through the Fire Marshall of Alexandria Township and pay the applicable fees according to the State of New Jersey fee schedule prior to an event; and

WHEREAS, temporary retail food vendors and event organizers of each event need to ensure they are in compliance with the Township of Alexandria's Special Event Ordinance 2020-005.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Alexandria, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, that:

Section 1. Section 102-2 A (3) and (4) of the Ordinance Code of the Township of Alexandria shall be and hereby is amended to amend the Township of Alexandria licensing requirements for mobile food vendors and temporary retail food establishments in accordance with the new Hunterdon County Health Department Temporary Food License Vendor License Requirements that are effective as of January 1, 2026.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final adoption and publication according to law.
